1. How to Register

2. Parents May Participate in Various Ways

- A. Parents may register for full class participation at regular class fees, being aware that classes are designed for the grade level indicated. Children receive priority in filled classes.

Parents may register for audit only for a fee of \$5.00 per class. Audit means that the parents simply observe, but do not participate in the activities.

1. Goal Keeping Camp

4. Advanced Goalie Camp

This class is a continuation of the basic Goal Keeping class. All participants must wear shin-guards, bring a number 3 ball, and bring a water jug. Class will be held at a soccer field near Ephrata Middle School.

6. Soccer Skills

This class teaches the basic fundamentals of soccer, offensive, defensive strategies, positioning, and fielding the ball. The class will stress positive thinking and good sportsmanship. All players must wear shin guards, bring a soccer ball, and a water bottle.

2. Advanced Fun and Games
